All in-office meetings, groups, drop-in programs, childcare services are cancelled. Women are encouraged to call LAWC at 519-432-2204 to schedule a phone counselling session.

With great regret and after serious deliberations, the London Abused Women's Centre (LAWC) will temporarily suspend all in-office services effective March 15, 2020 as we help minimize the impact of the Coronavirus on our community and country.

All women and girls with existing appointments or in need of appointments will be offered phone and Skype counselling.
